Emerging Issues in State Stormwater Management

Please join us for a presentation on the **Emerging Issues in Maine Stormwater Management**. The information presented will help you prepare yourself, and your clients, for coming changes in the State stormwater management processes.

Our speaker is Don Witherill, Director of the Division of Water Management, Bureau of Land and Water Quality at the Maine Department of Environmental Protection. Mr. Witherill is responsible for the revisions to MDEP stormwater management rules, and will be discussing the evolution of Maine stormwater management, progressing from 1997 through the 2005 revisions and the proposed changes going forward. He will also discuss the State's response to an EPA designation decision pursuant to the Clean Water Act affecting property in the Long Creek watershed and implications for other urban impaired stream watersheds.
