Long Creek Watershed; Issues and Solutions

The Long Creek Restoration Project is a collaborative, community-based initiative convened by the City of South Portland and led by a Steering Committee made up of representatives from the four Long Creek watershed municipalities (South Portland, Portland, Westbrook and Scarborough), area businesses, non-profit organizations, and state agencies. The City of South Portland obtained a grant from United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MeDEP) to partner with the other watershed municipalities and individual stakeholders in this effort. The Long Creek Restoration Project has been working since 2007 to develop a coordinated watershed restoration plan that will bring the stream back into compliance with state and federal water quality standards, and to open up new recreation opportunities for local residents and visitors.

Our presentation will feature a discussion of the watershed, the issues, the Initiative, potential solutions, and a presentation on one ongoing solution at the Maine Mall using porous pavement treatments.

Fred Dillon is an environmental professional with over 20 years of experience. As a consultant, he authored major portions of the Long Creek Program, and now in his new role as Stormwater Program Coordinator for the City of South Portland, he is administering the program

Ryan Hodgman is the Southern Region Environmental Coordinator for MaineDOT. He has over 8 years experience in highway and bridge environmental permitting, construction and compliance. During his tenure at MaineDOT, he has focused on the design and construction of stormwater, erosion, sedimentation and fish passage best management practices.
